About the role

The Nourish Program is a hospitality based educational pathway to employment for at-risk youth aged 16-25. The program is endorsed by a partnering RTO and is designed with a blend of foundation skills and hospitality training to best prepare the young people for study, employment and self-sustainability. Participants complete an 18-week program that is inclusive of a Certificate II in Kitchen Operations. Industry professionals and OzHarvest volunteers are engaged as mentors throughout the course and continuing beyond participants' completion of the program.

This role is to lead and oversee all aspects of Nourish, including program development, implementation, and evaluation. You will be managing the national Nourish team of trainers and youth workers, strategy, funding model, training framework, and reporting. You will be responsible for driving effectiveness and results, to maximise the impact of the program.

Responsibility 1: Staff and team management

- Cultivate and lead a collaborative geographically-dispersed team of 10+ people
- Coach trainers to ensure national consistency in program delivery
- Lead a team of youth workers, providing support and guidance
- Ensure ongoing training and professional development for staff
- Undertake staff recruitment as needed

Responsibility 2: Strategic management and program development

- Drive the strategic plan for the program
- Support constant improvement of results and impact
- Provide regular reporting on program results, underpinned by a solid monitoring and evaluation system

Responsibility 3: Program management, processes and administration

- Oversee the national program budget
- Lead collaboration with RTOs and hospitality faculties
- Establish and maintain the national systems required for day-to-day program delivery
- Ensure safety, good governance and compliance across the program, including via codes of conduct, duty of care, privacy policies etc.
- Adapt and develop the Nourish program as required
- Adapt program systems and procedures as required
- Maintain Nourish databases and systems

Responsibility 4: Represent Nourish and OzHarvest externally

- Cultivate and grow Nourish's financial and in-kind donors, including through regular program updates
- Work with the Impact Team to find, apply for and acquit significant grants to support the program
- Work with the Impact Team to develop communications materials to promote the program
- Cultivate national industry relationships to create and arrange work placement for program participants
